- Vocabulary: Cultural diversity - Celebrations
- Grammar: Defining relative clauses: who/that, which, where- No relative pronouns- indefinite pronouns-so/such... that
- Functions: Inviting – Persuading – Accepting – Declining.

- Vocabulary: Mobile technology- Touchscreen actions
