Explaining your call, taking a message, passing on a message.

Functions: inviting, persuading, accepting,

Grammar: Present Perfect Continuous;

Present Perfect Continuous vs Present Perfect Simple

Functions: Presenting a problem; listening, sympathising,
offering solutions; apologizing, asking for an explanation,
offering an explanation, asking for action.

Vocabulary: Crime, Justice and punishment.

Grammar: Past Perfect;

Past Perfect vs Past Simple:

adverbs of time.

Functions: introducing a story, sequencing, prompting the speaker,
reacting, checking the listener is following.
