<p>Grammar: comparative and superlative of adjectives and adverbs – <i>too much/too many; too/(not) enough</i></p> <p>Vocabulary: geographical features – weather</p> <p>Functions: asking about and comparing places, talking about geographical features, asking about and describing weather</p> <p>Skill and competences: developing a campaign to protect the environment</p>
UNIT N. 7 – Time for adventure
<p>Grammar: <i>be going to</i> - present continuous for future arrangements – present simple for fixed timetables</p> <p>Vocabulary: holidays – travel and transport</p> <p>Functions: giving directions and travel information</p> <p>Skill and competences: planning a responsible tour of your city/area</p>
UNIT N. 8 – What will be will be
<p>Grammar: <i>will</i> – <i>will vs be going</i> and the present continuous – zero and first conditional (<i>if</i> and <i>when</i>)</p> <p>Vocabulary: homes and contents - technology</p> <p>Functions: following and giving instructions</p> <p>Skill and competences: presentation of aspects of cyberbullying</p>
UNIT N. 9 – That's entertainment!
Grammar: present perfect – present perfect with <i>ever</i> and <i>never</i> – present perfect

with *just/already/yet – been vs gone*

Vocabulary: TV, film and theatre, music

Functions: starting and continuing a new conversation: introducing a topic, inviting others to speak, showing interest, moderating criticism

Skill and competences: producing a “What’s on” listing

UNIT N. 10 – Get the look

Grammar: present perfect with *for/since* – present perfect vs past simple

Vocabulary: clothes, fashion and style, jewellery

Functions: talking about clothes and style

Skill and competences: tracking your clothes, making a poster
