Gli argomenti affrontati sono stati tratti da:

- Libro di testo 1: **ENGAGE! 2, Student's book and workbook, + Language mind maps**, M. Berlis, J. Bowie, H. Jones, Edizioni Pearson Longman

Revision:

- Present simple and Past simple of regular and irregular verbs: affirmative, negative and interrogative sentences;
- questions with the auxiliary verb Do/Does/Did;
- Present and Past continuous; conjugation of the irregular verbs (table): Infinitive/Past simple/Past participle.
- General Functions: giving opinions and agreeing or disagreeing; asking for and giving opinions
- **Unit 4 - “Crime and punishment” – Grammar:** Past perfect vs Past simple, adverbs of time
- **Vocabulary:** crime, punishment, the justice system
- **Functions:** speaking about the topic in this unit

- **Vocabulary:** Health problems; people, places and treatments in healthcare
- **Functions:** Talking about health problems; asking for: giving, accepting, refusing advice and suggestions; describing symptoms and reacting
- **Unit 6 - “State of the arts” – Grammar:** Modals of deduction: Present and Past; question tags with them
- **Vocabulary:** Art jobs, events and places; types of art
- **Functions:** speaking about art; describing paintings and art works; describing installations; speaking about artists; speaking about the British museum and about other London's museums
- **Unit 7 - “Media matters” – Grammar:** The passive; Causative have/get; reflexive pronouns
- **Vocabulary:** Mass media; Broadcast media; media and communication; fake news
- **Functions:** speaking about types of papers and magazines; speaking about paparazzi and celebrities; explaining the stages of a process; asking for information; showing understanding or lack of understanding
- **Unit 8 – (capitolo avviato ma da terminare il prossimo anno) “Shop till you drop– Grammar:** revision: Zero and First conditionals
- **Vocabulary:** Money and shopping; ten shopping habits
- **Functions:** speaking about pocket money and forms of saving it; speaking about bank accounts for teenagers; speaking about your shopping habits; identifying and discussing options; coming to a decision; giving up
