Unit 1: In touch with your feeling

- Grammar: talking about the present: present simple, present continuous, present perfect
- Functions: asking follow-up questions

Unit 2: Enjoy the ride

- Vocabulary: travel, compound nouns, adjectives ending in *-ed* and *-ing*
- Grammar: narrative forms: past simple, past continuous, past perfect
- Functions: asking for directions, explaining how to get somewhere

Unit 3: Active lives

- Vocabulary: sports
- Grammar: past simple and present perfect; present perfect simple and continuous
- Functions: agreeing and disagreeing, an opinion essay, agreeing and disagreeing, narrating an event, how to write a story

Unit 4: Food

- Vocabulary: describing food, compound adjectives,
- Grammar: future forms will, may/might, be going to, present continuous, future



continuous, future perfect

- Functions: talking about hopes and goals, making predictions
- Insights: Healthy eating, the Mediterranean diet, the future of food “futuristic foods you’ll be eating in 30 years”, Food 2030
